- → Your annual lodge dues must be up to date.
- → Write a letter to our Lodge Secretary expressing your feelings. In your letter:
  - 1. Explain what you think the Obligation means.
  - 2. Describe how you have been fulfilling this Obligation in your troop and in your daily life, and how you have used your understanding of the Ordeal to aid in your service.
  - 3. Describe the specific plans you have for rendering service to the lodge in fulfillment of the new pledge you expect to take.

It is important that you not only meet the above requirements, but that you feel you are prepared for the Brotherhood.
