Dear Candidates for Order of the Arrow Membership,

We strongly encourage you to attend an upcoming Ordeal and to seal your membership this year. If, however, you are unable to attend this May's Ordeal, you will be able to complete your Ordeal Induction later in 2023 at either the June or October Ordeal induction. You will also remain eligible for OA membership for 18 months from the date of your election. So, for example, if your OA election was held during a troop, crew or ship meeting on March 30, 2023 you will remain eligible through September 30, 2024; after which you would need to be elected again by your fellow scouts.

Due to the coronavirus and the continued health and safety measures of the Spirit of Adventure Council, BSA and the States of Massachusetts and New Hampshire, Pennacook Lodge will be following all health and safety guidelines and protocols, including small workgroups, social distancing, and supporting the optional wearing of face masks. **Online event registration is encouraged.**

Attached to this email is a letter/checklist containing details of the Ordeal weekend. Please be mindful of the checklist focusing on bringing what is noted on the checklist. All participants will be required to submit the BSA Medical Form, Parts A & B only. This medical form is also attached hereto.

Upon arrival at camp on the first night of your Ordeal all candidates, youth and adult, and OA members, will sign-in with the health & safety officer, affirm he/she does not have symptoms of the coronavirus and is fit to perform a day of physical work. BSA activity permission slips will be required for all participants with those under 18 requiring a parent signature and those over 18 being able to sign themselves into camp. An Ordeal weekend permission slip is included as an attachment in this email and will also be available upon arrival at camp.

Please make every effort to attend an upcoming Ordeal and to become a new, VIP member of Pennacook Lodge. Remember that your fellow scouts have elected you for this honor and they expect something in return. You owe it to yourself and to you unit to take your Ordeal seriously; to learn, and to bring back a renewed spirit of purpose. During your Ordeal, listen and observe all things that go on with more than just your ears and eyes; listen with your heart and mind to seek and to understand.
