This letter will help you with registering and preparing for your Ordeal Induction. There are three Ordeal Inductions that will take place in 2023; you are welcome to attend any one of them to complete your membership requirements.

- Ordeal 1: Friday-Sunday, May 19 21, 2023 at Wah-Tut-Ca Scout Reservation
- Ordeal 2: Friday-Sunday, June 23 25, 2023 at TL Storer Scout Reservation
- Ordeal 3: Friday-Sunday, September 29 October 1, 2023 at TL Storer Scout Reservation

A Candidate and Parent Information Session will be held a week or two before each Ordeal and all candidates and a parent are expected to attend. Dates are yet to be set but will announced soon. The cost of 2023 Ordeal Induction will be \$70.00 per candidate, which include:

- Program & Food costs for the full event

- OA Member Handbook

- Pennacook Lodge Flap for wearing on scout uniform
- OA Uniform Sash

Please register and make payment online at <u>www.oapennacook.org</u> - event registration. Arrive and check-in at camp on between 7:30pm and 8:00pm. Please do not arrive before 7:30pm. At this time, you will complete the coronavirus registration, submit the signed event participation permission slip, Parts A&B of the BSA Health Form and inform us of any special medical and/or dietary needs and/or if you are carrying/holding onto any medications so the health officer/nurse may make any necessary arrangements.

Poncho/Rain Gear	Water bottle with water
Full Class A Uniform	Extra money; in case one wants to buy
	Lodge sportswear or OA gear

You will not need any additional gear. No food, beverages, or any electronic game devices are allowed. You will be asked to put aside all other non-essential and unnecessary items upon check-in. Under "scout's honor", Scouts will be allowed to bring and possess a cell phone, but for use in emergencies only.
